The Lady Prapai Sivagosak Border Patrol Police School was first established in 1987. It is very difficult to access due to the mountainous terrain and poor road conditions. This Thai government school offers basic education from kindergarten to grade 6. Many of the students are from the Karen ethnic minority group and live in remote villages that are far away from the school, therefore they have to board at the school. The boarding facilities were very small and overcrowded. Child's Dream built an additional boarding house with toilet facilities for the girls, and the boys will remain in the existing facility. Sadly, there was not sufficient funding for a safe water system. This changed in July 2012 when a SkyJuice safe water system was installed. The community supported the construction with manual labour and land preparation. The SkyHydrant water filtration system was supplied by the SkyJuice Foundation with funds donated by the Mitchell family in Albany, Western Australia. We thank Cameron, Iona, Tighean, Erin, Hamish and 'bump' for their fund raising efforts and generosity. This donation has made it possible for every child, community member and support staff to have access to safe water for drinking, cooking and hand washing each and every day. Your support means a lot to the children in this remote school in Thailand.
